

FREE SCHOOL MEALS/PUPIL PREMIUM

Dear Parents

From September 2014 all reception, Y1 and Y2 children will receive free school meals. There will no longer be the need to use the orange dinner envelopes. Every child will automatically be registered each day for their lunch. If your child is **NOT** staying for lunch during the week then parents **MUST** inform the school in writing at the beginning of the week stating dates in which your child is not staying. This is to enable the correct number of lunches to be ordered.

Free school meals/Pupil Premium

Parents who are in receipt of free school meals MUST obtain a 'Free School Meals and Pupil Premium' form from the school office. If any parent is in receipt of any benefits from the list below you must complete the Pupil Premium form.

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
- Working Tax Credit run-on
- Universal Credit

The school receives extra funding for pupil premium children so it is very important you inform us if you are in receipt of any of the above.
