

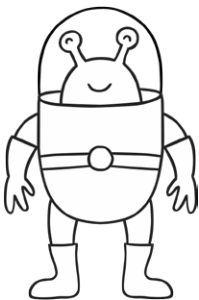
Application Activity

1. Imagine you have an alien friend. Write a paragraph of questions that you would want to ask them in your first letter.



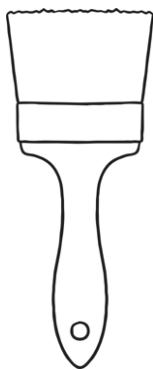
e.g. How many eyes have you got?
