


Year One Home Learning Challenges! 15.06.20

PSHCE	<p>This week we would like you to think about what is important to you. It could be friends, family, pets, toys... it could be anything. Have a think about why they are important to you then complete the sheet called Things I Treasure. Write what you treasure and why.</p>
Family Time	<p>Last week we have been playing lots of games inside as the weather hasn't been that nice. We have also been doing activities from the 100 things to do indoors list. We had an indoor picnic, made paper aeroplanes and had a toy's tea party. What have you been doing?</p>
