

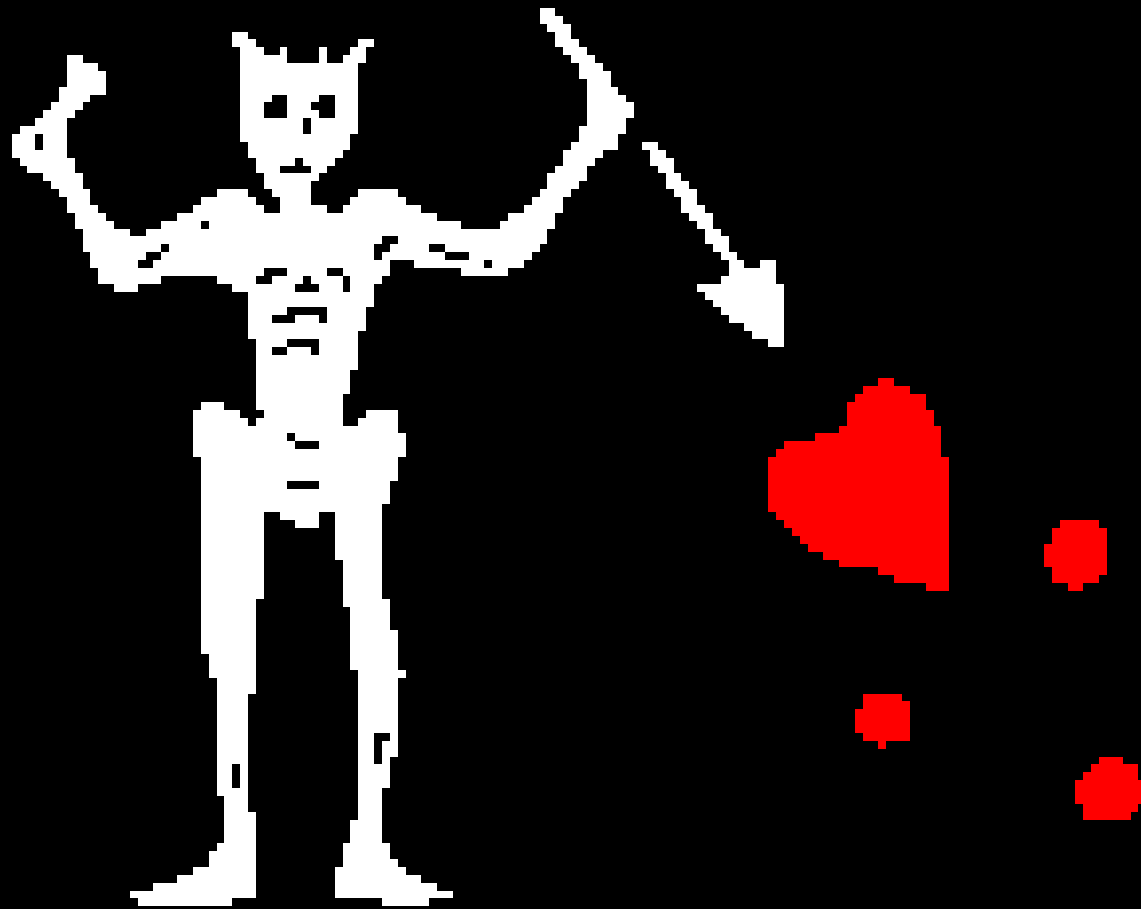

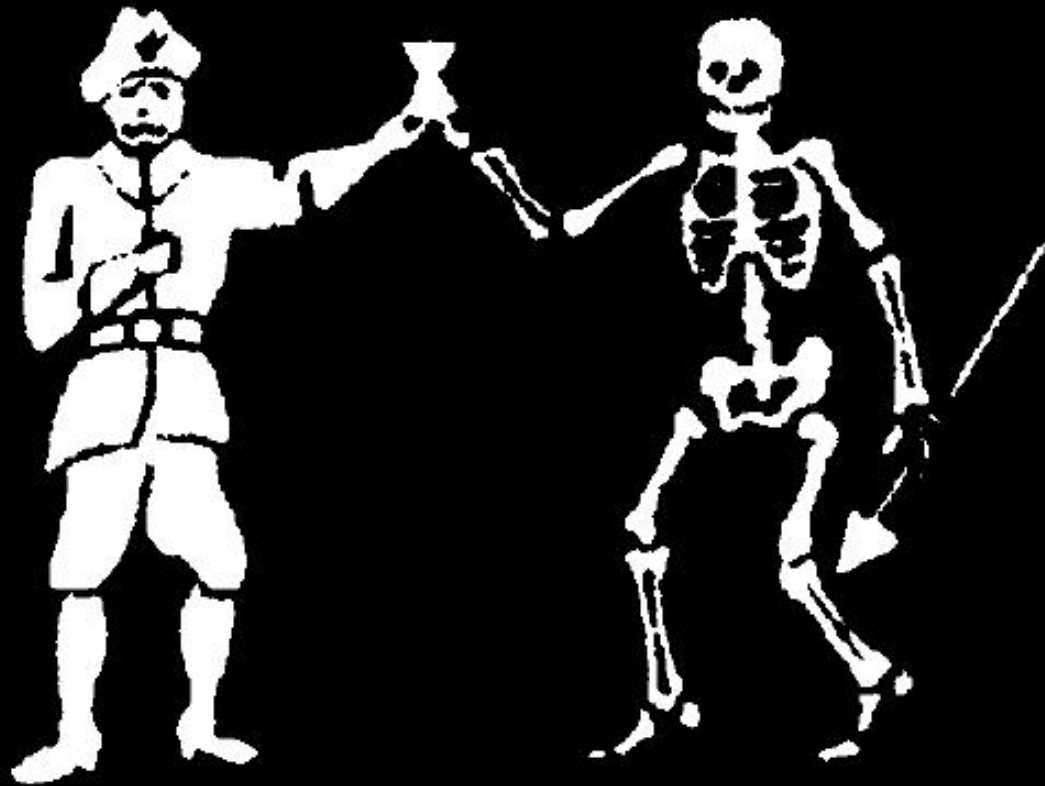

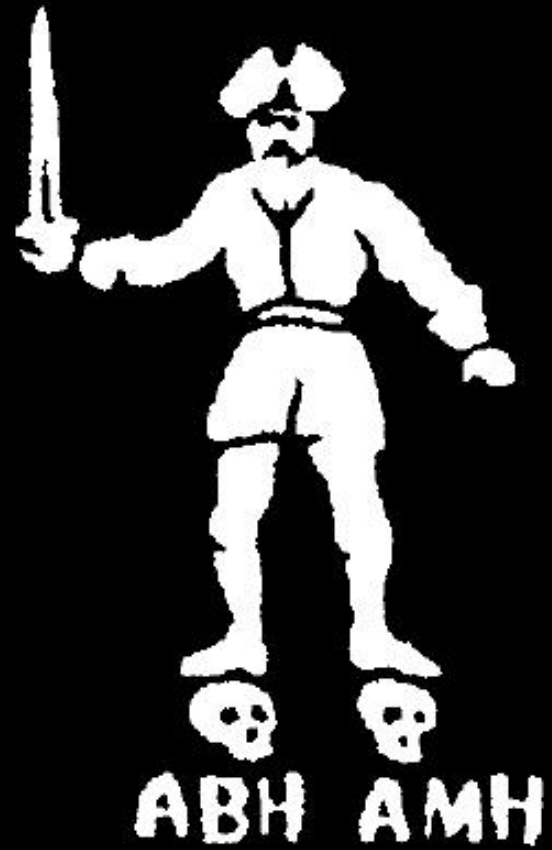

Pirate Flags

- Pirates flew flags on their ships as they sailed around the seas.
- These flags are now known as the Jolly Roger and are usually shown as a skull and crossbones which shows a human skull with two bones crossed underneath the skull on a black background.

Why were the flags used?

The flags were used to scare people that saw them. Pirates didn't live by the laws of the land and sea and they wanted to frighten people into thinking they would do anything to get what they wanted.

They hoped that people that were scared would surrender straight away without a fight.
