# Year One Home Learning Challenges! 06.07.20

<b>English</b>	Look at the Pirate Food PowerPoint. Would you like to eat the food that pirates had on the ships? Create a menu for pirates. Which foods will you choose? Draw a picture then write a little description of the food underneath.
<b>Maths</b>	Can you complete one activity a day from White Rose Home Learning? <a href="https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/">https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/</a> Summer term, week 11 WC 06.07.20 – Halves and quarters. There is a city on Education City with Maths games and I have also included some challenge activities. You will need some counters but can use anything - sweets, raisins, pebbles, pencils.
<b>Phonics</b>	Phonics challenges. Have a look at the challenge sheets. Can you find anything in your house that contains one of the digraphs or clusters? Can you sound it out and spell it correctly? (There are different levels in the files so select the one which is best suited for your child.)  There's games to play at <a href="https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/">https://new.phonicsplay.co.uk/</a> Access is free whilst schools are closed. The username is <b>march 20</b> and password is <b>home</b> . Also there's a phonics folder in the Classwork section of Education City.

<b>History</b>	Help! We need you to help capture some terrible pirates! Have a look at the Famous Pirates PowerPoint. These pirates need to be caught quickly. Pretend you are making a wanted poster to capture one of them. Why do they need to be captured? Will there be a reward? What should someone do if they see the pirate?  Have a think about all four pirates. Which one is the most horrible and why? Would you like to meet them? What would you say to them if you did?
<b>Art / D&amp;T</b>	Make a cardboard tube pirate. There are some instructions in the home learning file. What materials will you use? 

<b>Spelling</b>	<p>Choose 5 words each week from the Year 1 Common Exception Words. Each day spend 5 minutes practising how to spell them and also recognising what they look like so that you can read them without sounding out at all!</p> <p>If you can spell all of the Year 1 Common Exception words you could try some from the Year 2 list.</p>
<b>PSHCE</b>	<p>Think about your time in Year 1. What have you enjoyed? Christmas play, Christmas party, Spooky Day, finding out about Antarctica, learning about Africa, catching the evil pea. Complete the end of year sheet. You can draw and label your drawings or write...it's up to you how you complete it.</p>
<b>P.E.</b>	<p>There are so many fun ways to keep fit.
